Preliminary design of route



- Preliminary design report compiled
- Environmental impact assessment of preliminary design compiled
- Consultation with affected parties
- Affected property owners notified
- Roads & Transport MEC considers preliminary design, EIA and comments
- Final design published in Provincial Gazette

Proclamation of new railway line



- MEC notifies landowners / occupants / interested parties in writing
- Parties have 21 days to make representations
- MEC considers submissions
- MEC proclaims provincial railway line
- Proclamation published in the Provincial Gazette

Expropriation of land or rights



- MEC Notifies affected parties of land or rights to be expropriated
- MEC pays for land surveying / transfer costs
- MEC pays compensation to property owners
